## Giuseppe Arcimboldo



Arcimboldo was an Italian artist. He lived in Milan in Italy. He was born around 1526 and died in 1593.



This is Arcimboldo's self-portrait. He drew it using ink and a blue wash. No one is sure exactly when it was made.



Arcimboldo first job was designing stained glass windows. His father was also a stained glass window designer.



Arcimboldo also worked as the court decorator and costume designer.

Then he got a job as a portraitist in Vienna. This was an important job. Cameras had not been invented so it was the only way people could get a picture of themselves and their family.



Arcimboldo painted this portrait around 1563. It is a portrait of Maximilian II and his family. His wife was called Maria. Their daughter Anna is standing up wearing the orange dress. Their son Rudolf is behind them and their other son Ernst is in the cot.
