## Home Learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find your child's attached home learning pack.

If children are off school, it is important that they continue their learning at home, so activity packs have been prepared for your child to complete at home.

The packs also include our knowledge organisers for geography and science. These are particularly useful for learning and memorising key words.

In the pack there are the following:

### Maths:

- A booklet with fun activities to complete aimed at year 4 level
- Maths worksheets with topics we have covered over the year- there is squared paper attached for answers to be written on

### Reading

- Encourage children to read daily and continue to fill out their reading records.
- Reading comprehension sheets- lined paper attached for you to write your answers
- Reading response sheets based on books they have read or are currently reading

### English

We have been reading 'The Miraculous journey of Edward Tulane' at school. Your child could write the next chapter of the story (remember, Edward has been separated from Bull and Lucy, what may happen next?)

- Handwriting sheets have also been provided to practice handwriting
- Spelling- practice spelling words given from September using different spelling strategies

### Online work:

Children can log into **Timetable Rockstars** and **Sumdog** and complete maths games and activities if they have access to internet at home. Children will have access to **ALL** the games on Sumdog for the next couple of weeks.
