This week we received our report from the **National Child Measurement Programme** for children in Reception and Year 6 (2018-19). It is clear that as a community we have a responsibility to ensure that we change this current trend. 23% children in Reception were overweight or obese, by Year 6 this has doubled to 46 %. Let's work together to think about how we can ensure our children grow up healthily. Encourage your children to eat healthily at home: eating a balanced diet. Encourage your children to build in daily exercise: walking to school, joining clubs before, after school and at the weekend; swimming and playing games outside.
